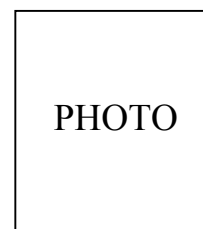

- 1. Public Education :** Promote hearing impaired awareness and organize training courses for volunteers. Volunteers are required to involve in the planning and operating process and give support to the public education events organised by the SADeaf.
- 2. Social Support:** This group aims at giving support to our Social Workers by regularly visiting elderly clients and hearing impaired children, give a hand to their daily lives, informing them about the activities of the Association. By doing that, we hope they can give our clients emotional support and if possible, organize activities for them. They will also give support to the Parent Support Group, Early Intervention Programme as well as tuition group.
- 3. Youth Beat:** The aim of this group is to focus on the deaf youth (3 to 30) to expose them to the hearing society, organize activities for this group and to help to built up their self esteem. If possible, identify deaf leaders for the Association. This group will be working closely with Sports and Recreation Committee of the Deaf.
- 4. Specialized Support:** This group of people are experienced in certain areas eg computer, language, photography etc. We will tap on their help when we need them.
- 5. Administration Support:** This group of volunteer is to give administration support to the office, eg data entry.

You will be invited for a Volunteer Orientation session within 3 months.
